
in Denmark invites to EUROPEAN HISTORICAL DIVING EVENT 2018 in Ebeltoft 24 - 26 August 2018

1000 Tour of the Frigate Jutland.


1100 Film about the salvage of the Kolding kogge is displayed in the auditorium of the Frigate Jylland.

Philip Nathansen and the Society will bring the following appliances: The Danish 2-bolt Helmet, The Miller-Dunn Divinhood Style 3, The Snert 0pen helmet, the Dräger DM 40 Injector, the US Navy Mk V 12-bolt, the DC 55 Mixed gas apparatus and the Dräger Model 138 oxygen apparatus.

To the extent that time permits, there will be opportunities for participants to test the devices.

Participants are invited to bring their own historical diving equipment and report this to the event master in connection with the registration.
